- To qualify for the Golden Quill Award the article must have been written and published in a newspaper, newsletter, magazine, website, etc., between October 1, 2009 and April 1, 2010. Winning stories will be published in Bowlers Journal International.
- No more than one entry per member per year will be accepted in this category.
- All entries received will be acknowledged by the Chairman to the email address provided on the entry.
- The Golden Quill Award will be presented to the winner at the CBW Annual Luncheon in Fremont in June 2010. Details on the exact date and location of the meeting and luncheon will be announced at a later date.
