

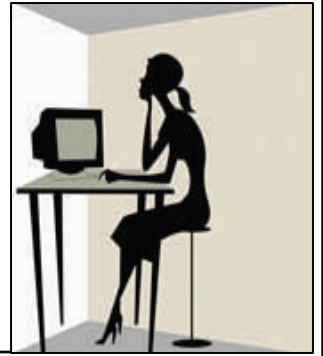

RULES:

- Story must be written by a CBW member in good standing.
- Length of article should be not less than 300 words and not more than 1500 words and carry the writer's by-line. If the byline is not printed by the publisher, a copy of the original draft must be attached to the published article sent with the entry.
- To qualify for the Profile Award the article must have been written and published in a newspaper, newsletter, magazine, website, etc., between February 16, 2009 and April 1, 2010.
- Article should include the subject's connection to the sport of bowling. Example: may be about an accomplishment, family tradition, proprietor, coach, senior, youth bowler, league member, etc.
- All entries received will be acknowledged by the Chairman to the email address provided on the entry.
- The Profile Award will be presented to the winner at the CBW Annual Luncheon in Fremont in June 2010. Details on the exact date and location of the meeting and banquet will be announced at a later date.
